About the book

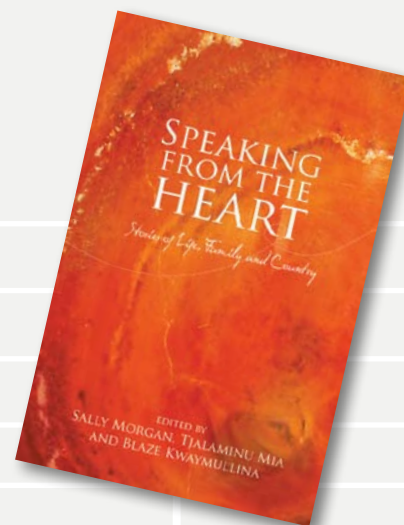
