About the author

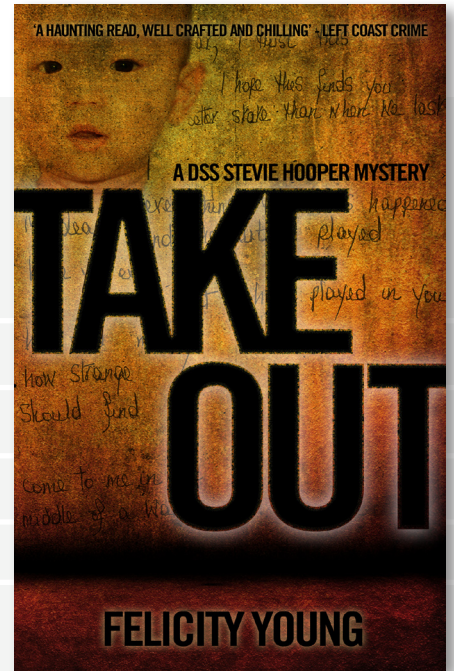
Felicity Young was born in Hanover, Germany, in 1960. She
