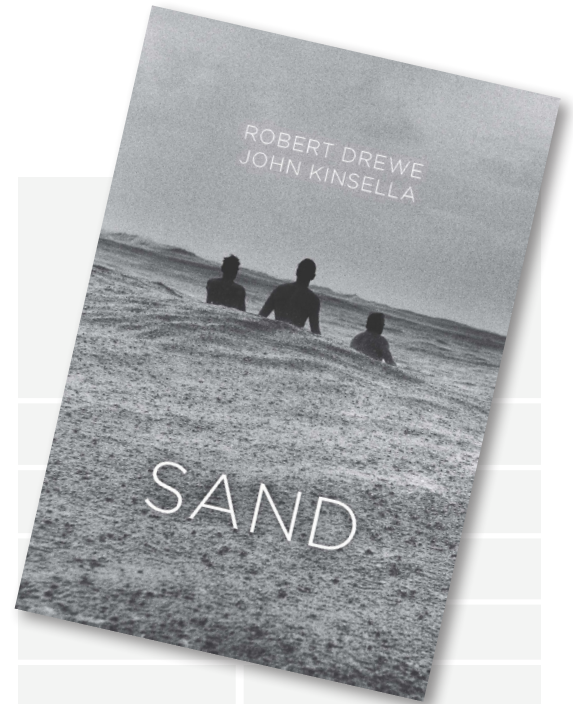
About the Authors

Robert Drewe is the author of six novels, four collections of short stories, and two works of non-fiction. He has edited five collections of short stories and prose. His novels and short stories and his prize-winning memoir, *The Shark Net*, have been widely translated, won many national and international awards, and been adapted for film, television, radio and theatre around the world.

John Kinsella has published more than thirty prize winning volumes of poetry and prose. His work is translated into many languages, including French, German, Chinese, Dutch, Spanish and Russian. Kinsella is a Fellow of Churchill College, Cambridge University, and was appointed the Richard L Thomas Professor of Creative Writing at Kenyon College in the United States for 2001.

He is also the WA theatre critic for the *Australian*.
- Three volumes of Kinsella's poetry have been published by WW Norton in the USA and eight books of poetry have been published in the United Kingdom.
