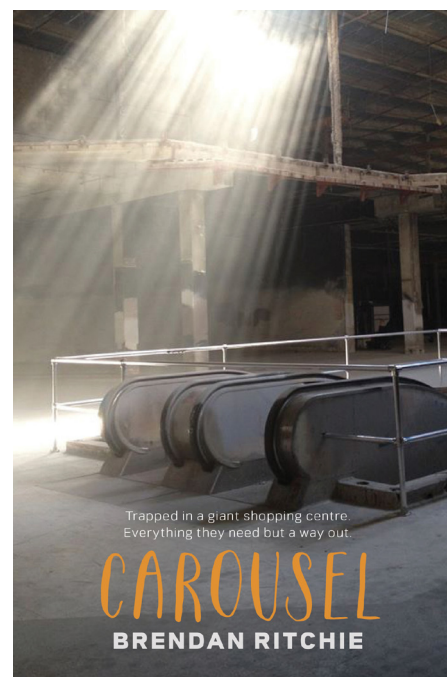
## ABOUT THE AUTHOR
