

‘How about this, kids — a traditional longhouse,’ says Pop excitedly.



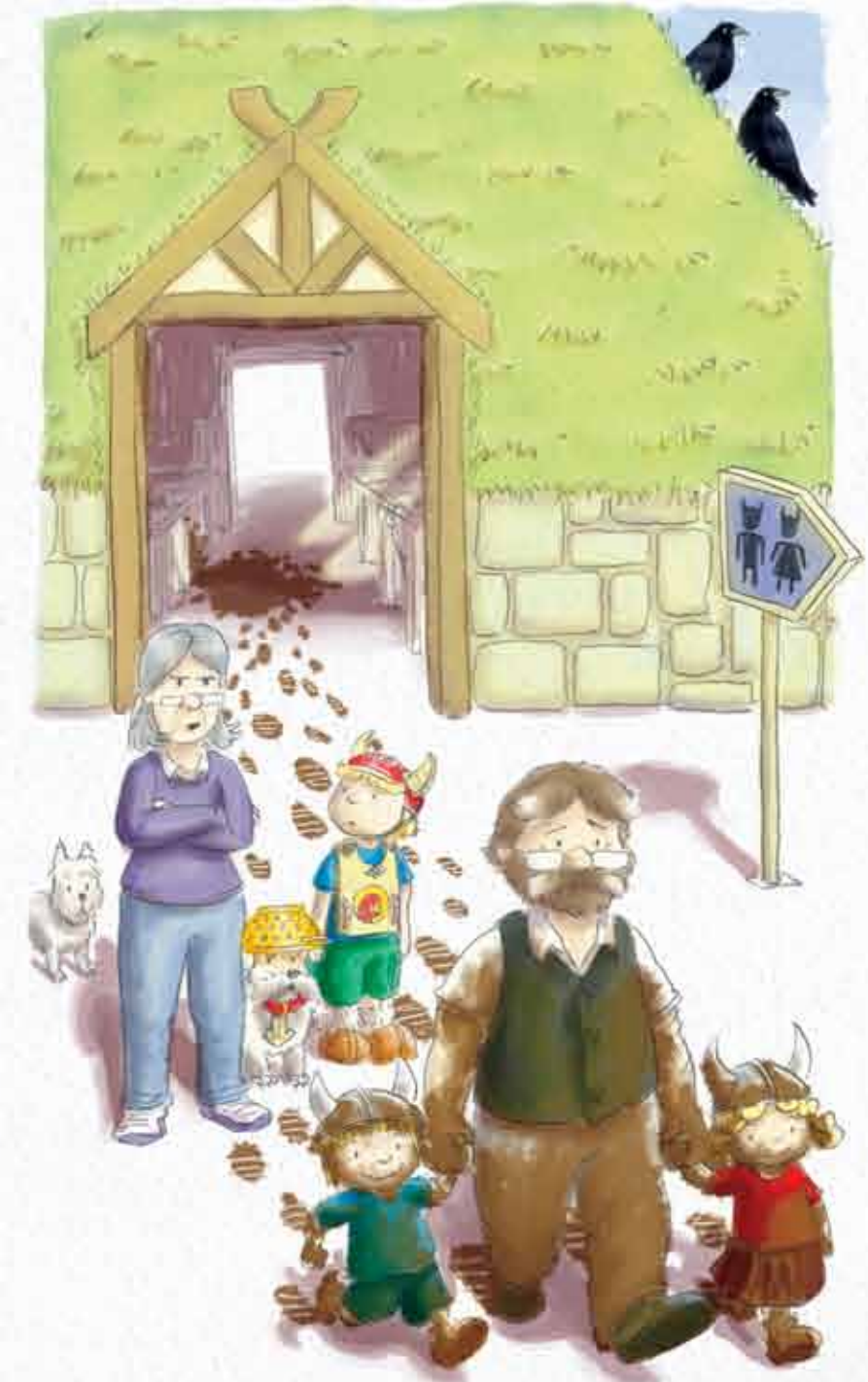
‘This is where Viking families lived together, along with all their animals, to keep them warm on the long cold nights.’

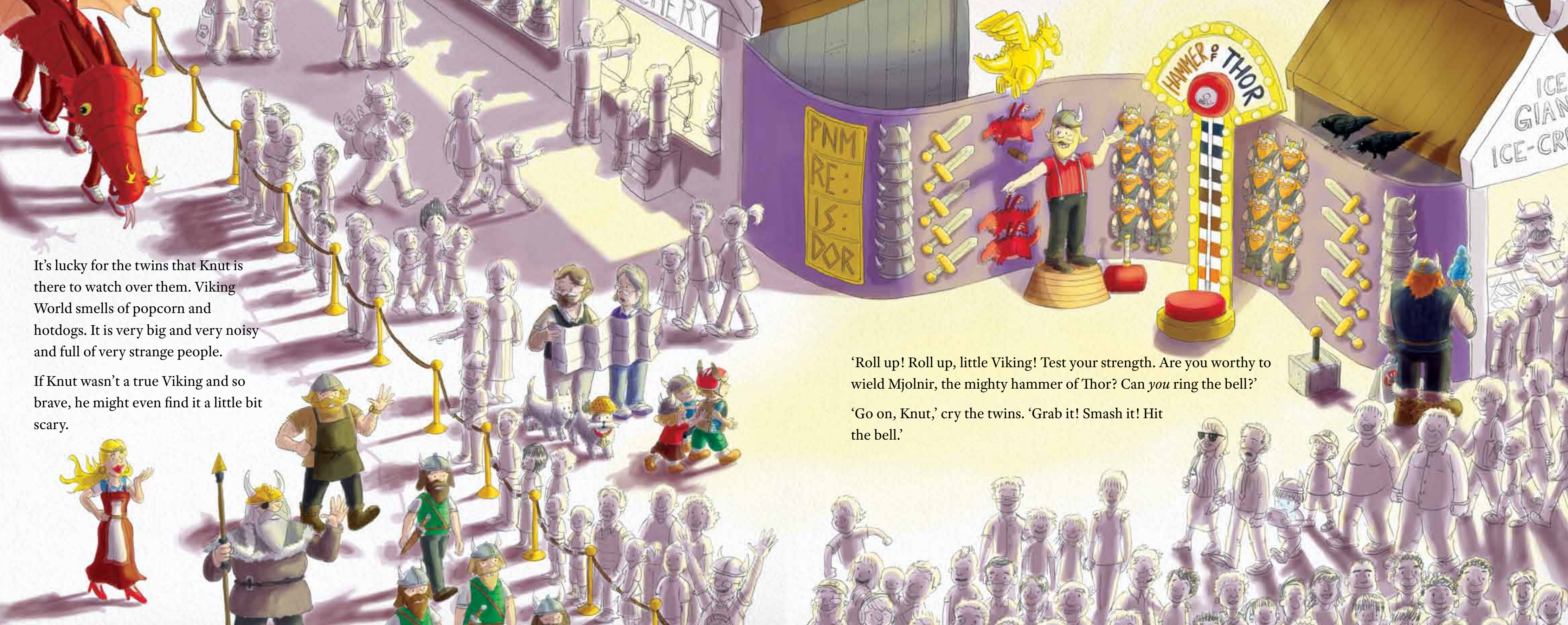


‘Pop, where are the twins?’ asks Nan, alarmed.
