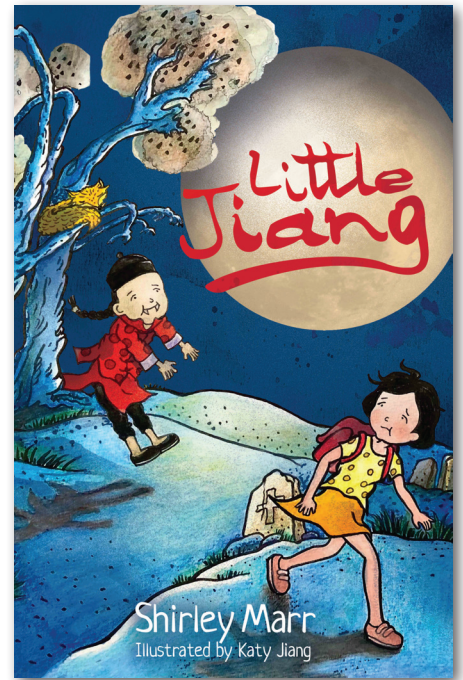
## KEY POINTS
